

We have found a bunch of the old newsletters from Brewery Creek in previous production, so here are a few fast facts from the May 1997 Volume 1, Issue 2:

- There were 141 Brewery Creek Mine Employees as of the end of April 1997
- 58% of Mine employees were Dawson City Residents, 31% Whitehorse, and 11% outside Yukon Territory
- Total amount of ore mined was 246,254 tonnes at a grade of 1.88 g/t
- 14,500 oz refined gold was produced to the end of March.
